RE: Measure Paving Program – 2021 EAST SIR FRANCIS DRAKE BLVD. PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

Dear resident/property owner:

In accordance with the Measure B Plan, pavement rehabilitation is proposed on East Sir Francis Drake (limits from approx. 195 feet east of Barry Way to approx. 100 feet west of Drakes Cove Rd.) next spring/summer (2021). Public Works staff is currently finalizing the project design and construction logistics. Although the construction hours have yet to be established, it is anticipated that work will take place at night, commencing after evening commute hours and ending before the morning commute begins. The paving work will require traffic control including lane closures and detours. The final traffic control plan will be developed based on further analysis of traffic conditions and assessment of potential impacts to surrounding homes and businesses.

In order to protect the City's investment in newly repaved streets, a **five-year prohibition of excavation will be in place immediately following the paving**. Should you need to excavate any portions of the subject street, the City encourages you to get ahead of the work as excavations will not be permitted except for emergencies for five (5) years after the paving. Please be mindful of the following timeline:

- By **April 15, 2021**, permits should be obtained and excavation work completed.
- No permits for work on Sir Francis Drake Boulevard will be issued after the construction start date (**tentatively July 2021**)

Work that may require street excavation includes (but is not limited to) the following: sewer lateral repair, home remodel projects that trigger utility service upgrades or conversions (fire sprinklers, electrical), driveway improvements, curb and gutter repair and sidewalk removal and replacement. At the request of Ross Valley Sanitary District (RVSD), information on available grant or loan funding to assist with costs of sewer lateral repair work is attached for property owners within their jurisdiction.

Please be aware that the homeowner is responsible for restoring the pavement to minimum Larkspur requirements following all work requiring street excavation.
