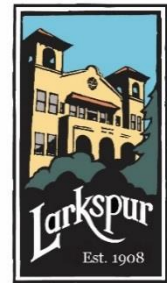

Election Guidelines

November 5, 2019 Election



Voter Registration Information

Registration Deadline for this Election

To vote in any election, a citizen must be properly registered 15 calendar days prior to the election date. The County of Marin Elections Department encourages all voters to be properly registered well before that 15-day deadline to ensure enough time for the Elections Department to complete postal delivery of correct and complete election materials prior to an election.

Voters may register online by visiting our website at www.marincounty.org/depts/rv the Secretary of State's at registertovote.ca.gov.

For the November 5, 2019 election, voters must be registered at their current residential address on or before Tuesday, October 29, 2019. Voters who miss this deadline may come to the Marin County Elections Department at 3501 Civic Center Drive, Suite 121, San Rafael, to complete a Voter Registration Form and be issued a Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) provisional ballot.

For Your Information

In order to remain eligible to vote, voters must re-register following these events:

- Change of residential address
- Change of name (first, middle or last name) and/or signature
- Change of political party affiliation

Postage-paid voter registration forms are available at these locations:

- U.S. Post Offices
- Public libraries and colleges
- City Halls
- Department of Motor Vehicles offices
- Marin County Elections Department

To be eligible to register to vote in California, a person must be:

- A citizen of the United States and a resident of California.
- At least 18 years of age by Election Day.
- Not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony.

Registration and Election Data

Pursuant to Elections Code Sections 2187(g) and 2188, voter registration information is available to candidates for election & campaign purposes.

Each request to purchase voter registration information must be submitted with identification on applications provided by the Marin County Elections Department. The applications, instructions and pricing can be found at www.marinvotes.org.

1. Use of this data, including but not limited to using registration information for purposes of communicating with voters, is allowed pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Division 7, Article 1, Section 19003.
2. Prohibited uses are pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 2194, and includes but not limited to any personal, private, or commercial purpose advertising, solicitation, sale, or marketing of products; or the harassment of any voter or voter's household.
