## City of Larkspur Heritage Preservation Board Notice of Vacancy

The City of Larkspur is accepting applications for one vacancy on the Heritage Preservation Board, created by the resignation of Fran Cappaletti on June 22, 2020. The individual appointed will serve the remainder of Mr. Cappaletti's term through June 30, 2022.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Larkspur or the portion of Greenbrae under the City of Larkspur's jurisdiction. Individuals with an interest in the City's history, architecture and preservation are encouraged to apply.

The Heritage Preservation Board compiled an inventory of historic resources and is responsible for maintaining and periodically updating this inventory. The Board also makes recommendations to the City Council pertaining to historical preservation matters and serves as a resource to provide advice to the Planning Commission.

The Heritage Preservation Board meets quarterly throughout the year on an as-needed basis to facilitate review of discretionary permit applications that affect a listed historic resource. Meetings will typically begin at 6:00 or 7:00 p.m. and are held in the Larkspur City Council Chambers, 400 Magnolia Ave., Larkspur CA. Board members are required to file a Statement of Economic Interest each year in office and must complete an Ethics Training every two years.
