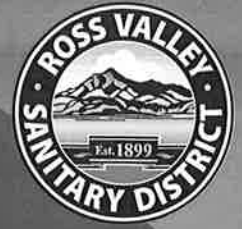

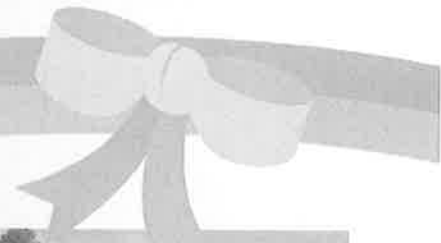

The Pump Station 12 Rehabilitation Project replaces outdated system infrastructure to enhance local wastewater system reliability and efficiency and to improve system performance during wet weather. Project benefits include increased capacity to match current daily wastewater inflow of 1.93 million gallons per day (mgd), new and upgraded piping, valves, electrical systems and generators, added bypass pumping capacity and more. These ratepayer-funded projects are needed to protect public health and the environment by reducing the risk of sewer overflows.
